
### **BETTY'S DELIGHT QUILT BLOCK**

BETTY WILSON WAS A LONG TIME MEMBER OF OUR QUILT GUILD. THIS IS TO HONER HER. SHE ALSO BELONGED TO A SMALL GROUP THAT WAS CALLED SHOO FLY. THE SECOND BLOCK IS SHOO FLY.



FABRICS: NEED TWO THAT ARE A CONTRAST TO EACH OTHER

FABRIC 1: 4 – 2.5" SQUARES 4 - 2.5" X 4.5" RECTANGLES 4 - 2.5" X 6.5" RECTANGLES

FABRIC 2: 4 – 2.5" SQUARES 4 – 2.5" X 4.5" RECTANGLES 4 – 2.5" X 6.5" RECTANGLES

STEP ONE: TAKE FABRIC 1 - 2.5" X 4.5" RECTANGLE AND MATCH FABRIC 2 – 2.5" SQUARE SEW TOGETHER

PRESS SEAM ALLOWANCE TO DARK FABRIC (FABRIC 2)

STEP TWO: TAKE A FABRIC 1 - 2.5" X 6.5 TO TOP OF THE ABOVE UNIT.

PRESS SEAM ALLOWANCE TOWARD THE DARK (FABRIC 2)
REPEAT FOR A TOTAL OF 4 UNITS.

### REPEAT EXCEPT SWITCH FABRIC AROUND

MAKE SURE YOU PRESS TO THE DARK (FABRIC 2)

PUT TWO DIFFERENT UNITS TOGETHER.

DRAW A LINE FROM POINT TO POINT (SEE DIAGRAM)

SEW TO THE RIGHT OF THE UNIT.

NOW YOU CAN TRIM AWAY THE EXCESS FABRIC.

OPEN UP AND PRESS TO THE DARK (FABRIC 2)

THIS IS ONE CORNER. NEED TO MAKE FOUR ALTOGETHER.

LAY OUT THE FOUR CORNER UNITS AS SHOWN IN THE PICTURE.

FROM HERE THE BLOCK GOES TOGETHE LIKE A FOUR PATCH.

THERE IS A FREE PATTERN. THIS IS THE URL FOR THE BLOCK.



## Shoofly quilt block




# Fabric Requirements for a A Finished Shoofly Quilt Block:

But I couldn't leave well enough alone and am going for a light background and 3 coordinating prints. Traditionally, only 2 colors are used in the block - a light for the background and a contrasting color.

background,
A=4 et 42,
background


C= 2 ats



## Step 4:

And press the seam allowances toward the Light/White squares as you can see in photo below.

take 5"sq and make 12 square Square block to 42" blocks sew



Sew the patches together in three rows as shown below just like you would for a basic Nine Patch block. (My tutorial for the Nine Patch is at https://fabric406.com/blogs/fabric406-blog/how-to-sew-a-basic-nine-patch-quilt-block)

4 of 4
