We want quilts to line both sides of the wide aisle at the entrances, the first quilts that our visitors will see. To accomplish this, we need LOTS of red and white quilts!

- The quilts may be any size, large, small and in-between.
- Quilts must be finished (3 layers, quilted and bound).
- They must be 2 colors only - red and white/cream. Shirtings will work but must "read" red or white/cream. The important thing is that the red "reads" red and the white "reads" white or cream.
- New and antique quilts will be accepted in this category.
- Sorry, no ribbons for this category, due to the varying nature of quilts.

Dig through your finished quilts and UFOs. finish any red and white UFOs that you may have, and if you've been wanting to make a red and white quilt, well, there's no better time!
